Lead Adult Care Workers are the frontline staff who help adults with care and support needs to achieve their personal goals and live as independently and safely as possible, enabling them to have control and choice in their lives. This Diploma is for experienced carers and senior carers.

The apprenticeship is work-based and online, so learners will not have to leave the workplace and can fit study around their day job

The Level 3 Diploma is built up from a selection of units. We'll help you put together the right combination to fit the job you're doing and the way you want to develop your career.

An Adult Care Worker must know and understand:

- The job they have to do to, their main tasks and responsibilities
 - The importance of having the right values and behaviours
 - The importance of communication
 - How to support individuals to remain safe from harm (Safeguarding)
 - How to promote health and wellbeing for the individuals they support and work colleagues
 - How to work professionally, including their own professional development
